

## **CPD Program-level requirement:**

# Ethical Practice

Australian doctors must dedicate part of their annual CPD time to develop their Ethical Practice. This requires completing at least one relevant CPD activity each year that addresses this requirement and aligns with their specific scope of practice.

All program-level CPD requirements are aligned to the Australian Medical Council's **Good medical practice: a code of conduct for doctors in Australia** (the code). It is suggested to start there when starting to plan CPD activities that are aligned with these requirements.

The code states that: "They must be honest, ethical and trustworthy... Every doctor has a responsibility to behave ethically to justify this trust".

To ensure Ethical Practice is being undertaken according to the Code of Conduct, it is critical ethical and legal obligations are upheld in:

- patient confidentiality and privacy
- research
- workplace and colleague behaviour
- · all other areas.

### How ACRRM CPD meets ethical practice

Ethical practice is included in ACRRM's Curriculum, practice domains and CPD program and specifies the requirement to work within the relevant national and state legislation, and professional and ethical guidelines. ACRRM CPD helps doctors to recognise and respond to unprofessional behaviour according to ethical guidelines.

The following self-directed activities align to meeting the requirements of addressing ethical practice:

- conferences, workshops, scientific meetings
- · skills / simulator / practical training
- supervision of registrars
- practice accreditation
- clinical attachment
- · morbidity and mortality meetings
